

For schools that are “Closed, Instructing” due to a pandemic:

1. There will be no recording of failing grades for the first week of implementation to allow students and teachers time to transition to a different method of teaching and learning.
2. Teachers will record one grade per week per subject in their gradebook.
3. Students will take a picture of their assignment with their phone or tablet and send it to their teacher for review and grading through Google Classroom, Class DoJo, Seesaw, etc. (Whatever method teacher has indicated to students.)
4. Teachers will provide feedback to students and allow for redo/retest.
5. Evaluation of student work and assignment of grades will be applied fairly and consistently. Students will not be penalized for the following:
 - the method used by the student to respond (digitally or hardcopy)
 - inability to access resources on-line to complete the assignment.
6. Grades earned through home instruction will be averaged with the current 6 weeks or 9 weeks grades to obtain an average.
7. For students who:
 - did not pick up a packet
 - did not log on to start an on-line assignment
 - did not complete and turn in any assignments for each week of closure
 - were not in the district due to other family members taking care of them

an incomplete will be recorded to allow a student to make up the work at a later time determined by the district.

NOTE: If student has no way to submit work digitally, the student will hold on to work and submit it at a later time determined by the district.
