ARTICLE I: NAME & PURPOSE

Section A: name – The Coyote Law Club

Section B : School Affiliation "The rules and regulations of the La Joya ISD shall be followed when not inconsistent with the rules and regulations of law enforcement."

Section C: PURPOSE – The purpose of this club shall be :

- To promote citizenship and active participation in society.
- To learn about the ways of the U.S. Government, Constitution, and law.
- To provide members with an understanding of how to pursue a career in law.
- To debate and investigate important issues in our society.
- To develop the qualities of patriotism, justice, and good will

ARTICLE II: MEMEBERSHIP

Section A: ELIGIBILITY – Membership shall be open to anyone who is committed and pursuing a career in law enforcement.

ARTICLE III : OFFICERS

Section A: The officers shall be a President, Vice- President. Secretary, Treasurer, Historian and Parliamentarian.

Section B: ELIGIBILITY – Officers must be full-time students

Section C: ELECTION- The officers shall be elected by ballot at the last meeting of the spring semester by a majority of the vote cast for that office.

Section D: TERM – The officers shall serve for one year and their term of office shall begin at the commencement of the fall semester.

Section E: VACANCY- If a vacancy occurs in the office of President, the vice-president shall assume the office for the remainder of the term and vacancies in any other office shall be filled by a special election.
