Program Options

The Fordyce School District's Gifted and Talented program provides services to meet the needs of the gifted and talented student both in the regular classroom and in extra curricular resources.

Options include the following:

Guidelines for Gifted and Talented curriculum for grades K-3

All students in grades K-3 will be serviced in the regular classroom and will be expected to use creativity and higher order thinking skills when working on gifted and talented lessons from Time for Kids, Primary Heaven, or teacher created lessons.

Guidelines for Gifted and Talented curriculum for grades 4-8

Students will be required to maintain classroom assignments and be committed to the requirements of the GT program. The GT curriculum will be product based. In the product based curriculum, the students will be required to complete homework from the GT curriculum, be responsible for projects such as but not limited to independent research, public speeches, and community projects.

Guidelines for Gifted and Talented curriculum for grades 9-12

Gifted and Talented students must be enrolled in at least one Pre AP or AP class to remain in the GT program.
