The Chief Financial Officer (CFO) reports to the Superintendent of Schools and is a member of the Superintendent's senior administrative team. The CFO has the primary responsibility of monitoring the financial well-being of the organization by directing and managing the operation of all financial and business affairs of the Madison Parish School Board including accounting, payroll, budget, risk, management, and tax collection. The CFO will serve as the chief financial adviser to the superintendent and locally elected School Board members. She/he will assume supervisory responsibilities over all financial operations. The CFO will define the processes and implement the infrastructure and systems needed to support continuous growth for the Madison Parish School Board.
