### Dress Code Policy for 2017 – 2018

#### INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

The information provided here was taken from the *Student Governance Policies*, regarding student’s footwear and clothing for the 2017– 2018 school year.

Tallulah Elementary Schools Tops	Polo or dress style shirts in light yellow or hunter green. Girls Crossover Tie (Optional). Pre-K - 3 <sup>rd</sup> grade
Wright Elementary Schools Tops	Polo or dress style shirts in white or burgundy. Girls Crossover Tie (Optional). 4 <sup>th</sup> - 6 <sup>th</sup> Grade
Madison Middle School Tops	Polo or dress style shirts in light blue (7 <sup>th</sup> grade) and navy blue (8 <sup>th</sup> grade).
Madison High School Tops	Polo or dress style shirts in gold (9 <sup>th</sup> grade), forest green (10 <sup>th</sup> grade), burgundy (11 <sup>th</sup> grade), and white (12 <sup>th</sup> grade).
<b>ALL STUDENTS/ALL SCHOOLS</b>	
BOTTOMS/BELTS/ SUSPENDERS	Slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers in khaki or navy belts/suspenders in solid black, brown, navy, or clear *Elementary school girls only are allowed to wear uniform plaid skirts/skorts and jumpers. No cargo pants of any color are allowed.
SHOES/SOCKS	All shoes are to be school appropriate footwear (flats, closed-toe and closed-heel), any color. No stilettos or Flip-Flops. Socks: One color and the same length
UNDERSHIRTS	Any color
COATS/JACKETS/SWEATERS/ VESTS/HOODIES/ SHRUGS	Coats may be worn with the exception of profane language, vulgarity, obscenity, or any abusive slogans or messages. Navy blue vests can be worn by both boys and girls.
BACKPACKS (CLEAR)	All students are required to have clear back packs.
