We, at Madison Parish School Board, are continuing our efforts to support your student's learning from home. All final grades have been calculated using the average from the grades for the first three marking periods and are available on the Parent Command Center. Students should make contact with their teachers no later than **April 27, 2020** to participate in the distance learning supplemental work option.
