The CIC Collected over \$27,000 worth of receipts this year. Thanks to all of our community members who contributed for our school!

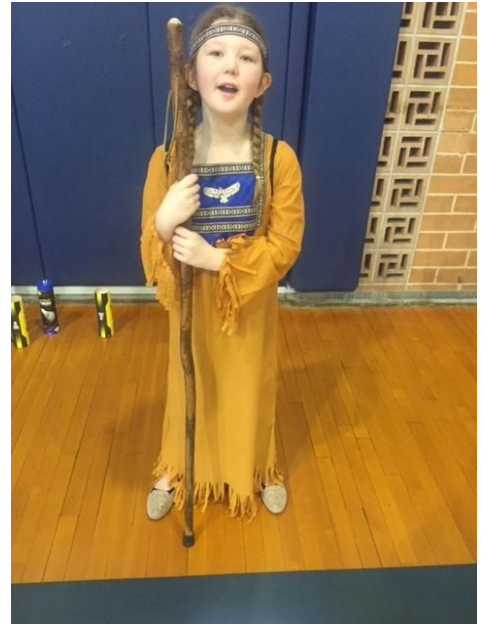
