- We use menus from the West Texas Coop. Most schools are on a 6-weeks cycle. 1 campus has a 4-week cycle to accommodate a student with severe fish allergy.
- Share Pan available: Put any unopened, unwanted items in the pan so others may take them. Do not throw away milk. The district pays \$10,000 monthly for milk. Suggested: Each campus should remind students unlimited fruits and vegetables are available (except potatoes).
