## **Belle Plaine High/Middle School Activity Policies**

Participation in extracurricular activities is voluntary and a privilege. Students who participate in extracurricular activities will be held to a high standard of personal conduct and must abide by Belle Plaine USD #357 policies as well as the rules set down by the KSHSAA. These rules will apply during the regular school year or from the first day of fall sports/activities each year and will end at the conclusion of spring sports/activities.

1. Academic eligibility will be according to Kansas State High School Activities Association (**KSHSAA**) Rules.
2. Students must be in good standing (not in violation of any school policy) to be eligible for practice or participation in activities.
3. The student must be in school a minimum of one-half day in order to be eligible for extra curricular activities. Only the building administration may make exceptions.
4. A student found to be using, in possession of, distributing, selling, or giving away any type of controlled substance or illicit drug may be denied the privilege of participating in the athletic or activity programs for the remainder of the school year (tobacco and alcohol are addressed in the next section). The consequences will be determined by the building administration. This policy will go into effect on the first legal day of fall sports/activities each year and will end at the conclusion of spring sports/activities. These guidelines shall also be in effect when students are away from school grounds or activities if a violation is substantiated by a reliable source.
5. Students **MUST NOT** use or have in their possession alcohol or tobacco products. Any student involved with these substances on school grounds, at a school activity, or while in any way representing Belle Plaine Schools, will be withheld from athletics or activities for a minimum of the next two competitions (games, or matches), in volleyball, boys/girls basketball, baseball and softball or the next one day of competition in football, cross country, and track. All suspensions will be at the level in which the participant competes. This penalty is based on the number of playing dates as set by the **KSHSAA** The building administration will determine the consequences for violations in non-athletic, extracurricular activities. Students will be placed on probation for all activities for the remainder of the school year. There may be additional consequences at the discretion of the administration. These guidelines shall also be in effect when students are away from school grounds or activities if a violation is substantiated by a reliable source.
6. The penalties above may be waived, at the discretion of the building administration, if a self-referral is made. A self-referral occurs when a student and/or parent voluntarily seeks information or assistance from a staff member. A self-referral will be considered legitimate only if it occurs before an offense, not as the result of a legal or school policy infraction.
  - The self-referral will be sent to the **HOPE TEAM** and the student will be placed on athletic/activity probation.
  - The **HOPE TEAM** will meet with the student and his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) to determine an appropriate recommendation designed to fit the needs of the student.
7. Athletic or activity probation means that if any further involvement with alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products becomes evident, the student will be immediately suspended from extracurricular activities for the rest of the school year.
8. When a student is suspended from an activity for any period of time, the coach/sponsor may require the student to attend all team meetings and practices and be present with the team during games, performances or competitions.
9. Disciplinary action will be handled on an individual basis, except for the disciplinary actions described above. Expulsion from the team will result if, in the judgment of the coach/sponsor, the student's actions reflect an irreconcilable attitude on the student's part. Lesser disciplinary action can be assessed resulting in a student being given a chance to prove his/her desire to remain on the squad/team.
10. The student will follow all rules and regulations that are established by the coach/sponsor and will respect the authority of the coach/sponsor while under his/her direction.

### **Extracurricular Activities/Physicals**

All students who are participating in athletics, cheerleading, or dance must have on file a completed Kansas State High School Athletics Association (**KSHSAA**) physical examination form before they will be allowed to participate in practices or games. The physical must be completed and the form dated after May 1st of the current year.

*We, the students, parents or guardians, have read and understand these policies. We understand this form must be signed and returned prior to participating in athletic or extracurricular activities.*

*\*\*Parents of students in athletics/activities are encouraged to attend a pre-season meeting prior to the student's participation for the purpose of reviewing this policy and other guidelines as set by the respective coaches/sponsors.*
