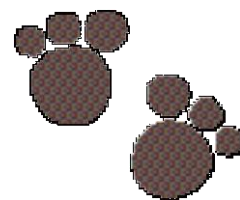

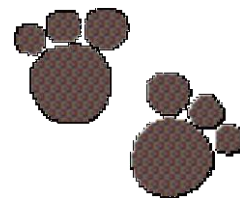
PARENT CONFERENCES

FLU SEASON APPROACHES

It is flu season time of the year. Encourage children to wash hands, get plenty of rest, and eat nutritious meals.
