

Munday CISD makes changes to school entrances and policies.

Beginning with the 2018-19 school year all visitors to Munday CISD campuses during regular school hours will enter into a secure vestibule. You will be checked in by an attendant who will either accept what is being brought for a student or allow you entrance to the building for an appointment or other school related business. You will be required to leave your I.D. at the entrance in order to gain entry. When you leave your I.D. will be returned to you. You will be issued a visitor badge to wear that is to be returned to the attendant when you leave.

Lunches are to be delivered to the secure entrance at least 15 minutes prior to your child's lunch time.

Changes to the secondary dress code include allowing shorts to be worn in grades 7-12 as long as the shorts are long enough that it is easily recognizable they are past the student's fingertips. Students in violation will no longer be allowed to wear shorts. Jeans or pants with holes or tears must be patched. As with other dress code issues the campus principal has the final say as to what is acceptable.

Cell phones will not be allowed out during the school day. Students may possess the phones, but are not to use them at any time without specific instruction to do so. Parents who need to contact their child during the school day need to call the office and leave a message for their student with the attendant or on the answering machine.
