

## 2022-23 Webster Jr. High School Mandatory Uniform Dress Code

For the 2022-23 school year, all students **MUST** wear the school-approved grade-specific uniform t-shirt, uniform long sleeved t-shirt, and/or uniform sweatshirt Monday through Friday; unless designated as a Spirit Day. The uniform t-shirt, uniform long sleeved t-shirt, and/or uniform sweatshirt may be purchased through Minden Athletic. **8th grade students will wear navy blue uniform t-shirts with navy or khaki pants, 7th grade students will wear light blue uniform t-shirts with navy or khaki blue pants, and 6th grade students will wear grey uniform t-shirts with navy or khaki pants.**  
**Pants/Walking Shorts: Navy or Khaki**

1. All pants, shorts, or capris are to be a **relaxed fit uniform style**— straight-legged and hemmed or cuffed at the bottom. Skinny legged uniform pants are not allowed. Style may be flat panel or pleated. All pants and shorts must have belt loops and zippers. Pants with brads are not allowed.
2. Pants and shorts should be made of cotton, cotton/polyester, or twill blends. No stretch fabric, spandex, nylon, sweat pants, or jeggings.
3. Pants and shorts may only have front pockets and two back pockets. Pants with pockets extending below the hip are not allowed. Painter or Cargo style pants are not permitted. Tight stretch fabric pants are not allowed.
4. Pants and shorts should not exceed actual waist measurement by more than two inches. Shorts should be within three inches of the crease at the back of the knee throughout the year.
5. A belt is required at all times. Note: Belt buckles should be no more than 2" x 2" in size with no offending emblem. Only tan, brown, black, or navy belts are allowed. No spikes or studs are allowed on the belt.
6. Pants and shorts must fit so that they cannot be pulled down over the hips.

### **Skirts/Skorts/Shorts/Jumpers: Navy or Khaki**

1. All skirts, skorts, shorts, and jumpers are to be a relaxed fit uniform style.
2. Skirts, skorts, shorts, and jumpers should be made of cotton, cotton/polyester, or twill blends. No stretch fabric, spandex, or nylon.
3. Skirts, skorts, shorts, and jumpers should be within three inches of the crease at the back of the knee throughout the school year.
4. Tights may be worn under skirts or skorts. The tights must be solid black, brown, gray, white, gray, or navy.

### **Uniform T-Shirts or Sweatshirts:**

1. Must be designated color for the grade level.
  - a. 6<sup>th</sup> grade students—grey uniform t-shirts
  - b. 7<sup>th</sup> grade students—light blue uniform t-shirts
  - c. 8<sup>th</sup> grade students—navy uniform t-shirts
2. Shirts must always be tucked in so that the belt is visible – no exceptions.
3. For undershirts-only black, white, gray, or navy will be allowed.
4. Students must wear the school approved uniform t-shirt under the approved WJH uniform sweatshirt any time the sweatshirt is worn.

### **Jackets:**

***\*PULLOVERS WITH HOODS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.***

***\*School approved uniform jacket may be worn inside any building at WJH at any time. The uniform jacket is optional, but if a jacket is worn, it must be the uniform jacket. The jacket is non-hooded, gray with full zip-up, with an embroidered WJH logo on the left chest. Jackets may be purchased from area retailers or may be purchased using the following link: <http://websterjrhigh.square.site/>. All jackets must meet the specifications of the uniform jacket.***

**General Appearance/Grooming:** *Students must be clean-shaven. This includes:*

- \* Sideburns, mustaches, goatees, or beards.
- \* Body piercing and tattoos should not disrupt the classroom learning environment.
- \* Oversized jewelry with widths larger than 1½" should not be worn are placed on clothing.
- \* No chains or spiked necklaces should be worn. Absolutely no wallet/pocket chains/straps are permitted.
- \* No athletic sweatbands will be worn on wrists, head, or neck except when allowed during P.E., or other athletic activity. **Bandanas are not allowed.**
- \* Girl's headbands must not be wider than 2".

### **Shoes and Socks:**

1. Shoes must fully enclose the foot (sandals and Croc-style shoes are **not** allowed. Backless shoes, sandals, house, and sports slippers are not allowed.
2. Shoes may be loafers or tennis shoes, as long as they meet the requirements.
3. All shoes worn should be matching pairs.

### **Caps/Hats:**

- \* In extremely cold weather, knit skull caps will be allowed outside on the grounds. They must not be worn in any building.
- \* NO baseball caps, do-rags, bandanas, or any other unacceptable headwear will be allowed inside of the school building.

### **Required Outfit for School Trips/Programs:**

***\*See required uniform.***

**Accessories:** \*\* NO neckties or bow ties (unless issued by a school-sponsored club or team), OR when worn in conjunction with a special dress-up day that is designated by the principal) \*\* NO scarves or blankets. \*\* Nothing that hangs from the belt or belt loops \*\* NO glasses or grooming items shall be stored on the head or around the neck. (ex. hair picks, glasses stuck in the hair or propped on the head).

**School Spirit Days:** may be designated as "Spirit Day". JEANS MUST BE BLUE OR BLACK SOLID JEANS. Jeans with holes, rips, and fraying may not show skin. Shirts may be approved school organization spirit t-shirts, currently approved school club t-shirts, or grade-appropriate uniform t-shirts.

**PARENTS:** *are expected to play an active role in controlling their student's dress according to the policy. **NOTE OF INTEREST:** IF ANYTHING COMES UP DURING THE YEAR THAT HAS NOT BEEN ANTICIPATED AND/OR COVERED IN THIS HANDBOOK, THE ADMINISTRATION WILL MAKE A DETERMINATION AND NOTICE WILL BE GIVEN. This will only happen if a particular problem comes up that has not been foreseen.*
