Esperanza Rising

- **OPTIONAL** project for ALL 7th grade Reading students. It is due the first day of school and will count as extra credit points for the major/test grade category.

*You will complete a total of **THREE** mini-projects. See attached rubric.*

You are **REQUIRED** to complete **ONE** item from this section.

- Make connections to the story, including a connection to your life, to another book you have read, and to the real world.
- Pick a scene that is described in detail in the story. Draw a detailed picture and then write your own description of what is happening
- Write a test/quiz for the book. Include 10 questions. Create an answer key.

You are **REQUIRED** to complete **TWO** items from this section.

- Complete a frayer model of the word Indignation. Decorate this in how it relates to the novel.
- Draw a picture of the main character, and then write ten words that describe the main character.
- Create a Quote Quilt by folding a blank sheet of paper into four sections. Write one quote in each section. On the back, explain why each quote is so important. Remember to include color, design, and/or illustrations in your "quilt".
- Create a timeline of events from Esperanza Rising. You must include at least ten major events and an illustration that correlates with the events.
- List parts of the text that appeal to each of the five senses. Be sure to include the quote, the sense it appeals to, and the page number where it can be found.
