School might have been closed most of the week, but court (basketball) was still in session.

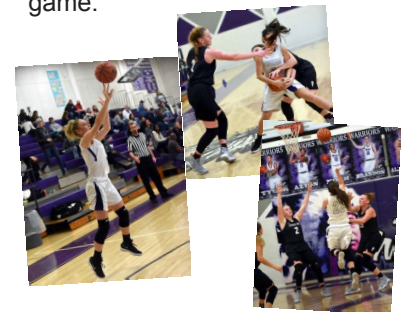
