Bonham -- A walk-off double in the eighth inning by Brooke Aaron drove in the game-winning run in a 6-5 win by the Bonham Lady Warriors over the Aubrey Lady Chaps. After four innings, Bonham had a 4-3 lead, with starting pitcher Mackenzie Downs driving in all four runs. Aubrey tied the game in the top of the fifth frame and the Lady Chaps slipped in front, 5-4, in the top of the sixth. An RBI double by Carsyn

Hemby in the bottom half of the frame tied the game, 5-5. A scoreless seventh inning sent the district contest into extra innings. Bonham's defense held Aubrey in check in the top of the eighth, leading to the extra-inning heroics by Aaron in the bottom of the eighth that gave the Lady Warriors an exciting 6-5 win. The win by Bonham leaves the Lady Warriors and Aubrey tied for third place in District 11-4A with 4-3 records. Carsyn Hemby went 4-for-5

with an RBI and also scored once. Brooke Aaron was 3-for-5 and drove in the game winning run. Shelby Jones, Raegan Shackelford and Joli Kirkpatrick all had two hits apiece, while Mackenzie Downs, Madison Wrape, Chyrsi Hemby and Averi Reeves each had one hit. Downs picked up the win and Roos was tagged with the loss. The Bonham Lady Warriors travel to Melissa April 10.

BHS Baseball Drops Game To Aubrey After Late Score

Bonham Warriors stayed in it until the end, but Aubrey pulled away late in a 3-2 victory on Tuesday. Aubrey trailed 2-1 in the top of the seventh inning when Brendan Milacek doubled on a 0-2 count, scoring two runs.
