<p style="text-align: center;">Health and Safety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Due to Covid-19, food deliveries and visitors will not be allowed ● Efforts will be made to limit social interaction including: classroom arrangement and cafeteria. ● Temperatures will be taken on teachers, staff, and students upon arrival at school. ● Students, faculty and staff will be sent to the nurse in a designated area if temperature is 100.4 or higher. Parents/guardians will be called immediately if temperature is elevated when taken by the nurse. ● Social distancing will be practiced, where feasible.
