<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Health and Safety</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Due to COVID-19 food deliveries and visitors will not be allowed.</b></li> <li>● Staggered lunch and recess</li> <li>● Hand sanitizer at each entrance</li> <li>● Social distancing will be practiced, where feasible</li> <li>● Face coverings are required where social distancing is not possible.Ex. School buses, hallways, etc.</li> <li>● Frequent sanitization of surfaces and buildings</li> <li>● Students and staff stay home when not feeling well and/or have been exposed to COVID-19</li> <li>● ADH guidelines will be followed for students or staff who test positive for COVID-19</li> <li>● Contact tracing will be conducted by the ADH</li> <li>● CDC guideline posters will be in visible areas throughout the building</li> <li>● Water fountains will not be used. Water filling stations will be installed and students will have to bring their own clear water bottle to refill.</li> <li>● Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized multiple times throughout the day.</li> <li>● Teachers will sanitize their classrooms as needed:</li> <li>● During interventions and small groups, teachers will sanitize the work area during that given time. Using gloves, teachers will spray disinfect on each desk and chair. Students will not take part in cleaning and sanitizing the classroom.</li> <li>● Activity teachers will sanitize their classroom before and after their classes.</li> <li>● Breakfast &amp; Lunch is TBD based on the number of students in the building.</li> <li>● There will be no sharing common materials or resources in the classroom.</li> <li>● Masks will be worn during dismissal. Buses will be dismissed through the office as they approach the campus.
