Dear SCCSD Learning Community,

Great News! The United States Department of Agriculture has extended through December 31st, 2020 the summer meal program. What does this mean? It allows the SCCSD to provide breakfast and lunch to children up to the age of 18 **NOT attending on-site instruction at MPS, MES, MIS, MJHS, & MHS** and living within the boundaries of the school district.

Beginning on **Saturday, September 12th**, the SCCSD will distribute meals for each child up to the age of 18 **NOT attending on-site instruction at MPS, MES, MIS, MJHS, & MHS** and living within the boundaries of the school district a week's worth of breakfast and lunch. The meal will be picked-up at **Morrilton High School**.

How does a family place an order for the meals for children up the age of 18? A family can place their order for meals for children to be picked-up on Saturdays beginning on September 12th and ending on December 19th the following way:

1. Go to and complete the electronic form prior to 3:00 p.m. on the Thursday prior to picking up the meals on Saturday at **tinyurl.com/sccsdlunchorder**, and place an order listing the names of the children up to the age of 18 **NOT attending on-site instruction at MPS, MES, MIS, MJHS, & MHS** and living in the household.

This step will be repeated on every Thursday for orders to be picked up on the following Saturday.

You may pick-up your meal order Morrilton High School on each Saturday between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon. In an effort to be safer, all lunch transfers will have to be picked-up by those receiving the meals. The SCCSD will no longer hand the bags to people. You will have to get out of your vehicle and physically pick-up the meal bags.

What are some examples of the meals for the children up to the age of 18?:

1. A ½ gallon of milk for each child up to the age of 18 living in the household.
2. Five (5) days of breakfast for each child up to the age of 18 living in the household.
3. Five (5) days of lunch for each child up to the age of 18 living in the household.

This will replace the meals that Devil Dog Virtual Academy students have been ordering and picking up for each day of school. **Beginning on Saturday, September 12th all Devil Dog Virtual Academy students will pick up their meals for the week at Morrilton High School.** Devil Dog Virtual Academy students will still need to complete the lunch order form electronically at **tinyurl.com/sccsdlunchorder** so the SCCSD Child Nutrition staff can plan accordingly.

Thank you for your support of the SCCSD and allowing our District to serve your family.
