Original Minutes of Monthly Meeting

November 28, 2016

Location of meeting: Harleton Boardroom

Carl Wright began the meeting at 6:00 pm by with roll call of members.

Approval of minutes:

- Minutes were read by Carl Wright from October 24, 2016 meeting. Motion by Harvey Fox and second by John Peteet to approve the October 24, 2016 building committee minutes as read. Voting for: All. Voting against: None. Motion carried.

Discussion and Input from Committee:

- Ore City Tour – Layout is functional, useful, cost effective, dual purpose rooms, storage in rooms and shared in hallway. Kept it simple with 8 ft hallways, no lockers, wood framed and composite roof. Restrooms in classroom for lower grades. They have cafeteria but could be larger. Bare bones gym. Cost \$126 per square ft. to build seven years ago. This did include parking lots but excluded demo because it was a new location.
- Harleton Tour – Need space and storage, maintenance issues (neglect or why not fixed) disappointed in long term maintenance of facilities. We need to show good faith in taking care of things. Should we salvage one building and build one new campus possibly utilize primary, junior high and cafeteria. What to do with junior high gym?
- Location possibly split up elementary and junior high campuses
- Find out how much land would be needed if we found a different location?
- Look in to wash stations in hallway at cafeteria
- Possible pay off existing bond to show good faith (Perception)
- Look for other schools to tour with elementary and junior high together or separate. New Summerfield and Harmony were mentioned.
- More information to public in order to get a bond passed
