Dear Parent/Guardian,

We look forward to seeing your child in July for our **Elementary "Full STEAM Ahead!" Summer School program** for students entering 3rd through 6th grade during the 2020-2021 school year. Due to increased enrollments and in an effort to keep class sizes small for social distancing, we will again be in **two buildings** for the July session. Students who are entering grades *3-6 will have class at the Upper Elementary*. Once again, the July summer school session will be held on Mondays – Thursdays only *(no school on Fridays)*. The dates for this summer session are **July 6 – 23, 2020 from 8:00 am – 2:15 pm.** Breakfast and lunch will be available to your child during summer school at no cost to your family.

The summer school doors will be open for drop off from 8:00-8:20 am. If students arrive after 8:20, they must check in at the front office. Please be sure to drop your child off curbside, exiting the passenger side of the car, at the entrance that is specific to your child's grade level as shown on the map, unless you are dropping your child at Before School Care. Before School Care students will enter through the normal Before School doors each morning, as shown on the map. Before school care is \$1 per day or \$12 for the summer school session. If you arrive before 8:00, your child must wait in the car with you until the doors open at 8:00, or they can attend Before School for \$1.

All students must be screened prior to entering the building. We will check temperatures and symptoms upon arrival. If a student has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, he or she will not be allowed to attend. A student must be fever free without medication for 24 hours before returning. Since we are emailing this information, your child will bring his/her car tag home on the first day. For the July session, all cars will enter through the main entrance, and all students will be picked up at the front doors. Even though 5th and 6th graders will exit through the 5th and 6th grade doors, it is important that they walk to the front doors before entering the car for safety reasons. Please see the map if you have questions. *It is very important for the safety of all children, that your child does not walk around the front or back of the car when being picked up, but instead, enters on the curb side of the car.*

All 3-6 students who are attending After School Care, will stay at the Upper Elementary for After School Care. *If your child is going to attend After School Care, you will use the normal After School entrance to pick up your child.* After School Care is open until 6:00 pm and is \$5 per day or \$60 for the summer school session.

Again, we appreciate your patience as we navigate these interesting times and continue getting students ready to come back to school in the fall. Thank you for allowing your child to attend "Full STEAM Ahead!"
