Dear Parent/Guardian of a Senior at LRHS:

The Class of 2022 has been one of the best at beginning the college and career application process early. It has been very encouraging to see the amount of acceptance letters coming into the counseling office. Our College & Career Readiness Day is rescheduled for **Thursday, March 3rd**. We will be giving our freshmen, sophomores, and juniors assessments that morning to determine how they are progressing toward college readiness and career inventories to learn what career fields they may be interested in pursuing in the future. They will also be scheduling for next school year in the afternoon.

We know what seniors need now more than anything is time - the time to schedule college orientations, the time to interview for a job, the time to set up a job shadow experience, and the time to work on scholarship applications. Therefore, on March 3rd, we are giving our seniors time to plan an off-campus college and career readiness experience.

They must develop a plan for how you will use the day to meet their college and career goals. The plans must be submitted for approval by March 1st.

If the senior has an approved plan, then your off-site learning experience will not be considered an absence. The counselors are available to assist seniors if they need help setting up a visit or job shadow experience.
