

Greenbrier School District Concurrent Credit Information

The following courses are offered for concurrent credit at Greenbrier High School. Please note that some courses count as two courses at the college level. The fee associated with these courses is \$100.00 per class at the college level. Therefore your child will be billed twice for the courses that count as two courses at the college level. A copy of the student's account statement can be found in the student's BOSS account. All bills will be paid to the school and the school will pay UALR. Students should review their BOSS accounts frequently.

Below you will find the requirements to be enrolled in Concurrent Credit. These requirements must be met and proof of test scores and GPA must be in the counseling office **no later than Friday, May 24, 2018 for the 2019-2020 school year** to be eligible for Concurrent Credit. **Due to class size, faculty, and course offerings, if your child does not qualify for Concurrent Credit they may be moved to a different course.**

Requirements to be enrolled in Concurrent Credit: Students must have a GPA of at least a 3.0 AND

ACT = 19 Composite, 19 Reading (21 for 9th grade), 19 English, 21 Math OR
Compass exam = Reading -83, Writing - 80, Algebra - 45 OR
Accuplacer exam = Reading - 78 (86 for 9th grade), Sentence Skills - 83, Elementary Algebra 80

*The ACT/Compass/Accuplacer Math section requirement only applies if a student is taking concurrent credit math, science, or medical terminology. **The Composite, Reading, and English sections requirement must be met to take any concurrent credit course.**

The Compass exam has been replaced by the Accuplacer exam. Compass scores already on file will be good for five years.

Concurrent Credit is a way for your child to prepare now for their future. While the staff of GHS and UALR work very hard to make sure all students are enrolled in all courses for which they qualify, **it is ultimately the student's responsibility to check enrollment status and to keep track of their college transcript.**

I understand what Concurrent Credit is, what the eligibility requirements are, when those requirements must be met, and that there is a fee associated with the Concurrent Credit courses that I will have to pay by the deadline set by UALR in order for my child to get college credit through the Concurrent Credit program.
