Superintendent Goals 2018-2019

- 1. English I and II EOC results have improved. Increase passing rate by 6% for the 2019 assessments.**
- 2. Work with our teachers to understand the importance of our students not only passing the STAAR assessments, but for all students to show improvement from one year to the next.**
- 3. We will continue to explore strategies to help our Special Education students be more successful on the STAAR test. The district has added personnel to achieve this goal.**
- 4. District teachers will continue to challenge our students academically, even more than in the past. When we raise the bar of expectations, I believe our students will meet those expectations.**
- 5. We will do a TASB Policy Review this school year. This review will involve administration, campus administrators and the School Board.**
- 6. The district will make every effort to make sure that all students at Malakoff High School will be identified as college ready by the TEA. This effort will include increasing the number of students taking the ACT/SAT college entrance exam and the TSI exam.**
- 7. The district attendance rate will remain over 96% for the 2018-2019 school year. The 2016-2017 attendance rate was 95.9%. The 2017-2018 attendance rate was 95.6%.**
- 8. Improve our mentor teacher program to assist our new teachers and those new to the district. We have more new teachers or new to the district than in past years.**
- 9. The district will add computer coding for the elementary campuses and the Middle School for the 2019-2020 school year. The district will also increase CTE opportunities for Malakoff High School students in 2019-2020.**
- 10. All schools will continue to have a safe and orderly environment where students can learn to their greatest potential. The safety and security of our students and staff will remain our highest priority.**
