

Mask Information

Drew Central School District will highly encourage the wearing of masks inside buildings and while on buses by both adults and students when social distancing is not possible. If Drew County, according to CDC, and/or Drew Central School District, according to the Drew Central School District POC, using the CDC Screening Testing Recommendations for K-12 Schools by Level of Community Transmission as a guide, percentage rate reaches 7%, a Moderate Transmission Rate, masks will be mandated until the number of positive cases falls back into the low transmission (below 5%). The 7% mask mandate will also apply to individual schools, grade levels, and classrooms.

As of Friday, August 13, 2021, there are 108 cases in Drew County. That is within the <3% range county-wide. We highly encourage the wearing of masks on Monday unless that number increases to a percentage 7% or greater. Masks will help prevent the possibility of needing to quarantine when a positive case occurs.
