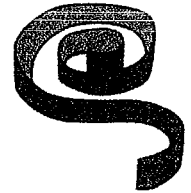
2 Reggio has 24 yards of ribbon. She wants to cut it into 6 pieces. How long will each piece of ribbon be?

c.  $72 - 9 = 63$

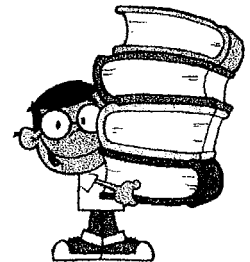


4 A librarian has 60 new chapter books. He puts them on 5 shelves. He puts an equal number of books on each shelf. How many books are there on each shelf?
