L'Angleterre/Londres (f) = England/London

La Manche = the English Channel

L'Espagne (f) = Spain

La France = France

Le Luxembourg = Luxembourg

La Suisse = Switzerland

L'Italie (f) = Italy

La mer Méditerranée = the Mediterranean Sea

L'Amérique du Nord (f) = North America

Le Canada = Canada

La Province de Québec = Québec
