Assignment Instructions

Up to this point in the class, you have learned how to conjugate many different kinds of verbs. These include:

- Etre
- Avoir
- Aller
- Faire
- -ER Verbs
- -IR Verbs
- -RE Verbs

Etre, Avoir, Aller, and Faire are all irregular verbs, which means that they each have unique sets of forms that don't follow a pattern like -ER, -IR, and -RE verbs. These four are the most commonly used irregular verbs and are applied in different verb tenses and expressions. However, they aren't the only irregular verbs in the French language. Look at the next four irregular verbs below. They're grouped together because, even though they are considered irregular, they do all follow a similar pattern. Look also for patterns that are similar to -ER verb endings!

Dormir

je dors	nous dormons
tu dors	vous dormez
il/elle/on dort	ils/elles dorment

Partir

Je pars	Nous partons
Tu pars	Vous partez
il/elle/on part	ils/elles partent

Sortir

je sors	nous sortons
tu sors	vous sortez
il/elle/on sort	ils/elles sortent

Servir

je sers	nous servons
tu sers	vous servez
il/elle/on sert	ils/elles servent
