Objectives

After completing this activity, students will be able to . . .

- Conjugate -RE verbs in sentence context



Assignment Instructions

Conjugating -RE verbs is just like conjugating -ER and -IR verbs, just with different endings.

Step 1: Remove the -RE at the end of the verb infinitive.

Step 2: Look at the subject of the sentence, and add the correct ending to what's left of the verb infinitive.

Here are the endings for -RE verbs:

Je -s	Nous -ons
Tu -s	Vous -ez
Il/elle/on -[nothing]	Ils/elles -ent

Note that the ending for il/elle/on is to add absolutely nothing! Do not add any letters after you take away the -RE.

Some common -RE verbs are:

- perdre - to lose
- vendre - to sell
- répondre - to respond
- attendre - to wait
- entendre - to hear
- rendre visite à - to visit someone or something
