- Parking spot reservations must be made by lunchtime on October 19th.
- Groups must provide their own tables, if needed. Spots must be clean and neat at all times. Spots must be clean by 9 pm. All trash must be deposited in receptacles or removed from premises.
- Decorating contest winners will be determined solely by vote of a panel of judges.
- No pets please. Service animals only.
- Masks must be worn by Trunk or Treat spot sponsors during the event.
- In the case of inclement weather, the event will be rescheduled.
