

Administration Goals

The purpose of school administration is to help create and foster an environment in which students may learn effectively. All administrative duties and functions should be appraised in terms of the contribution that they make to better instruction and to increase student motivation and achievement.

The Board shall rely on its chief executive officer, the superintendent of schools, to provide the professional administrative leadership that such a goal demands.

The design of the administrative organization shall be such that all departments of the district and all schools are part of a single system subject to the policies of the Board and implemented through a single chief administrator, the superintendent.

The principals and all supervisory personnel are expected to administer their units in accordance with Board policies and administrative regulations. However, the mere execution of directives cannot and should not, by itself, be construed as good administration. Vision, initiative, resourcefulness, leadership, students, and parents are essential in effective administration of schools.
