

Exemptions from Required Instruction

If the religious belief and teachings of a student or his or her parents or guardian are contrary to the content of a school subject, or to any part of a school activity, the student may be exempt from participation.

To receive an exemption, the parent or guardian must present a written request for exemption to the principal stating the conflict that is involved.

If a student is unable to participate in a physical education class he or she may present a statement from a physician stating the reason for the student's inability to participate. The statement or request for exemption will be presented to the principal annually in cases of extended illness or physical disability.

Exemptions from required instruction will not excuse a pupil from the total semester hour requirement for graduation.
