

Isolation and Maintenance Payments

EEAA

Some children in the district reside a long distance from a school that is in operation and from established bus routes. Students fitting this description may be considered "isolated" and, therefore, entitled to isolation or maintenance payments as established by the Wyoming statute and Wyoming State Board policy.

Isolation or maintenance payments shall be established by the Board of Trustees in compliance with state statutes and the regulations of the Department of Education and State Board of Education. Generally, students residing 2.0 or more miles from school or an established bus route may be eligible for isolation or maintenance payments.

All persons making application for isolation or maintenance payments shall be informed at the time the application is filed that the necessary forms with signed claim vouchers must be submitted to the business office at the end of each month for which reimbursement is claimed. Mileage will be paid to the nearest bus route or school, whichever is determined by the school district to be closer.
