It is the intent of the Board to study state and federal legislation, selecting those parts of the legislation which will help the Board to provide better educational opportunities, better environment and better physical and mental growth for each student.

The Board authorizes the superintendent to execute and file applications for and in behalf of the school district and to act as its authorized representative in matters concerning such funded programs.

All proposals for state and federal aid and special grants must be submitted to the Board for approval prior to final submission to the agency concerned.
