

School Bus Scheduling and Routing

Bus routes, schedules, and stops will be developed under the direction of the superintendent. The purpose of bus scheduling and routing will be to achieve maximum service with a minimum fleet of buses consistent with rendering reasonable and equal service to all students.

Bus routes will follow state and county roads and highways. Parents will be responsible for getting their children to established bus routes.

Children living within the city limits will not be eligible to ride school buses. Exceptions will be made for qualified handicapped students.

The Board will review and approve all bus routes recommended by the transportation supervisors.

On those approved routes where there are students picked up on an intermittent basis and the routes are extended beyond the established rate of payment, the driver shall submit a voucher for the additional work time required.

With regard to non-public school students, parents or guardians of the students must submit a written request to the Board of Trustees through the Superintendent of Schools for approval. Upon approval, non-public school students may ride the buses on a space available basis, boarding on the regular routes established by the Board with disembarkment sites to be approved by the Board if other than at the public school building.
