
Student Demonstrations

JFI-R

The following rules and procedures will apply in the event of any student protest or demonstration at any building within the school district.

If there are individuals among the protestors who are not enrolled students in Crook County schools, law enforcement officials will be called to forcibly eject those individuals.

The names of student protestors will be taken and should they refuse to return to their assigned student station, their parents or guardians will be called to come and remove the students from the premises.

Law enforcement personnel will be used to confront Crook County students only when it becomes apparent that the intervention is necessary to protect the lives of or prevent injury to school administrators, staff members, other students or employees of the district.

Attempts will be made to learn the real cause of the disturbance. No disturbance will be tolerated that disrupts the educational process of the school or interferes with the rights of other students.

The penalty for participation in a protest may range from reprimand to expulsion and will be made after a review of the circumstances in each individual situation.

The principal or superintendent will have the right to take any measures necessary to restore order.
