

Student Organizations - District Funding

JRDA

All student organizations, which expend school district funds, will follow fiscal management procedures established by the Board.

School sponsored student academic groups, clubs, or activities other than those sponsored and/or sanctioned by the WHSAA must receive the approval of their building principal and the superintendent to travel within the State of Wyoming to activities and/or events.

A maximum amount of \$4,000.00 will be budgeted annually for each of the secondary schools. In addition, \$13.00 per secondary student (number of students to be calculated from the October 1 enrollment of the preceding year) will be added to this budget category per school. This amount will be available to help fund the actual expenses for room, board and/or travel for student groups and their school sponsors to events which exceed the 300-mile limit established by the state, events which are not WHSAA sanctioned, or events which are not on the culminating event list. Each secondary school, under the leadership of its principal, (a committee is strongly suggested) will prioritize funding from this budget category for potential trips by school groups to perform, compete or participate. Any additional funding needed is the responsibility of the individual student academic group, club, or activity involved. All out-of-state trips must have prior approval by the Board. The principal must then submit a travel sheet to central office for each approved trip stating the amount that will be expended from this out-of-state travel account.

Student activities and organizations which participate in district funding other than for purposes of sponsorship and transportation will submit an annual budget which reflects anticipated expenditures, anticipated revenue, and net reimbursement needed from district funds.

A maximum amount of \$1,000.00 will be budgeted annually for each of the elementary schools. In addition, \$6.00 per elementary student (number of students to be calculated from the October 1 enrollment of the preceding year) will be added to this budget category for each elementary school. This amount will be available to help fund actual expenses for room, board, and/or travel for student groups and their school sponsors. School board approval will be required for all overnight events out of Crook County before any individual school or class can participate. Each elementary school, under the leadership of its principal, will prioritize funding from this budget category for any planned out-of-county trips in which students will perform, compete, or participate.

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
