Neiman Timber Co., L.C. – will be awarding three \$1,500.00 scholarships to graduating seniors from local area high schools for their second semester of college classes. Persons eligible include students that have made plans to attend a public college, university, or vocational school in the fall after graduation. Persons applying for the scholarship must have an affiliation with Neiman Timber Company and the timber industry. Neiman Timber Company will make the selection from a recommendation made by a committee that has reviewed the scholarship applications. The monies will be paid to the enrolling institution and must be used for tuition, books, or a combination of both. The criteria to receive the scholarship is to be enrolled as a full time student and earn twelve (12) credit hours your first semester, enroll as a full time student your second semester, and maintain a 2.5 grade point average your first semester. Payment will be made after proof of enrollment for the second semester, grade point average and earned credit hours for first semester have been submitted to Neiman Timber Company.
