

BASKETBALL FAN ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

Below are the guidelines and protocols that Hulett High School will be following for fan attendance at basketball games. Please adhere to these guidelines at ALL times. We want to make sure our kids can participate for the entire season. WHSAA does have the authority to take away our post season play if we are not following their guidelines. Please do your part to make sure these hardworking athletes get to continue competing.

Student athletes:

- Home team/school will screen their athletes and participants, including table workers and officials. Visiting schools will have screened their athletes prior to getting on the bus.
- Teams will only be allowed 12 players suited up. Players should be assigned a seat on their respective benches. The other team(s) or members will be in our multi-purpose gym.
- Hulett School only has two locker rooms, so showers will NOT be available to visiting schools. We have a small changing room located in the main hallway for visiting teams. This will be sanitized before your scheduled contest.
- Face coverings are required at all times while in our school unless you are on the court playing.
- Bring your own water bottles, and do not share with others.
- Hand sanitizer is located on the scorer table by each bench for hand sanitizing.

Spectators:

- Face coverings are required at ALL times. Face shields ARE NOT considered face coverings at WHSAA events. Your face covering must cover your mouth and nose AT ALL TIMES!
- There will be NO food or beverage allowed in the school building.
- Home spectators seats are designated on the wall above our bleachers as are the visiting fans and our band.
- We are only allowed 25% of the max capacity of our seating as set forth by the State of Wyoming Health orders. Hulett school gym is not large enough to reach the 100 seat max therefore, seating availability will be calculated on an event by event basis.
 - The breakdown will be figured each Monday of a home contest (depending on if we will have cheerleaders or our band).
 - If it is a Monday or Tuesday game, it will be figured the Thursday prior to the event and the allotted number will be sent to the visiting school.
 - We will be following the 60/40 rule between home and visiting spectators.
- Home fans: Each player and coach gets 2 fans in attendance. NO OTHER FANS WILL BE PERMITTED. The games will be available to stream free of charge on NFHS.
 - This number INCLUDES small children. So please don't have 2 fans show up with a child, as only the 2 with their names on the list will be allowed in.
 - You will still be required to sign up with names prior to the event or you will not be permitted.

- Cheerleaders and band members **MUST** stay in their assigned seats. Regrettably, we will not be able to allow any spectators for our cheerleaders or band members, as this would take us over our allowable fan limits.
- A list of home fans will be required to me the day prior to the event. If you are not on the list you will **NOT** be allowed in the building. Please do not make this awkward, as we all know each other, and I don't want to have to deny anyone at the door.
- Visiting fans: Will get between 35-39 fans, depending on our band and cheerleader attendance. I will send the number out to the visiting AD prior to the game.
 - We will require a list of names for attendance. Those on the list will be the only ones allowed entrance. This number **INCLUDES** small children. So please don't have fans show up with a child, as only the 2 with their names on the list will be allowed in.
 - If your name is **NOT** on the list you will not be allowed in the building.
- **ALL FANS:** Please stay home if you are having any symptoms of COVID-19.
 - We have COVID symptom checklists posted all around the school, and all fans entering will be asked if they are displaying any symptoms. However, if you are displaying symptoms, please stay home, get healthy and enjoy the game from home on the NFHS, for free.

We apologize for the inconveniences for all fans, players, parents and coaches. It is not our intent to make things any more difficult for anyone. Our one and only intention is to the keep the kids in school and to keep the kids participating in activities. Remember, this is all about the kids! Failure to comply with our procedures could result in our kids losing out on post-season play. You will also be asked to leave if you do not follow these guidelines and if you are asked to leave at more than one event you may not be allowed in to the school for the rest of the season of play. I truly appreciate and thank you all for understanding and complying with these guidelines that **ALL** schools must follow this year!
