

COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES

Under law, the parent or guardian of any child residing in this state whose seventh birthday falls on or before September 15 of a given year and who has not yet attained age 16 or completed tenth grade must send the child to public or private school. The child must attend during the entire time that the public schools of the District are in session.

Exemptions of children of compulsory attendance age in this District will be governed by Board action on the basis of law and District policy.
