Just a few more weeks until Christmas break! This means FINALS are just around the corner. Students can utilize the WIN program and Saturday school if they aren't feeling ready for finals. I am also happy to meet with students to help them prioritize their to-do lists and help navigate the stress this time of year may bring.

Juniors can earn a full-ride scholarship this year! The Calvin Coolidge Scholarship application must be submitted by January 16, 2019 at 5:00pm Eastern Standard Time. There is not a limit to the number of students who can apply from each high school. Students of any background who are planning to pursue a college degree beginning the fall of 2020 may apply at coolidgescholars.org.

As this semester comes to an end and students are busy preparing for finals, it is important to remember that many of the large colleges have application deadlines that are fast approaching. Make sure your student has completed their FAFSA and has checked those due dates. Spring will bring the majority of the scholarship deadlines, but there are a few more for this year listed below. Our school website and the senior Google Classroom contain the most updated list of scholarships available.

1. National Honor Society Scholarship - Seniors in good standing may apply for 600 scholarships.

Applicants must be currently enrolled at or planning to attend a four-year university, graduate program, community college, or trade school.
