

Asynchronous Remote Instruction for 2020-2021 School Year

For the 2020-2021 school year, C-CISD parents may choose for their child to receive instruction at school in a traditional setting or via remote instruction. C-CISD will be utilizing Asynchronous Remote Instruction for the students that choose remote learning. This type of remote instruction will only be available online.

Asynchronous Remote Instruction is instruction that does not require having the instructor and student engaged at the same time. In this method, students learn from instruction that is not necessarily being delivered in-person or in real time. This type of instruction may include various forms of digital and online learning, such as prerecorded video lessons or game-based learning tasks that students complete on their own, and pre-assigned work and formative assessments made available to students on paper.

Parents that choose Asynchronous Remote Instruction will need to do the following prior to July 28, 2020:

1. Complete Online Registration in Parent Portal.
2. Complete the Asynchronous Remote Instruction form in the campus principal's office prior to the above date. Call each campus office between 8:00-4:00 Monday -Thursday to make an appointment to see the campus principal.
3. Students and Parents must sign a remote instruction contract.
4. Check out a Chromebook or technology device.

Things to consider before selecting Asynchronous Remote Instruction for your child for the 2020-2021 school year:

1. If remote instruction is selected, it will be for the entire 9-week grading period.
2. Students that choose remote instruction are not eligible for participation in any extracurricular activities nor practices, nor performances.
3. Remote instruction will be conducted 100% online (no paper packets).
4. Attendance will be taken daily, and will be mandatory.

5. Parents will need to monitor their children during remote instruction for up to 6 hours a day.
6. Remote instruction will consist of videos of their teachers teaching, assigned reading, assignments, tests, projects, etc.
7. Grading for remote instruction will be the same as in class.
8. A daily remote instruction schedule will be followed.
9. Students and parents will need to know how to access the internet, use technology, and Google Classroom.

Overview of Asynchronous Remote Instruction:

1. Remote instruction will mirror what is going on in the classroom.
2. Teachers will record the lesson in each subject they have, then post in Google Classroom.
3. Teachers will post activities that will be turned in daily by the student.
4. Teachers will make similar assignments they make in the classroom.
5. Teachers will assign similar tests and Content Based Assessments they give in the classroom.
6. Scheduled times for daily student work will be posted in Google Classroom.
7. Remote learners will have from 7:45-4:00 to access videos and assignments, and turn in all work.
8. Additional assignments will be given with specific due dates.
9. If/when a student is struggling with an assignment, they will need to email their teacher. The teacher will then contact the student through one of the following; email, Google Classroom discussion, phone call or video conference.
