

College Assistance Migrant Program **CAMP**

What Is CAMP?

The College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) at Texas State Technical College (TSTC) in Harlingen is a federally funded program designed to meet the needs of students with migrant and seasonal farm-working backgrounds. CAMP offers eligible students pre-college transition and first-year support services to help develop the skills necessary to succeed in college. CAMP collaborates with TSTC faculty, student services, outreach programs and community-based agencies to improve educational and career opportunities for all CAMP-eligible students.

Who Is Eligible?

To qualify for CAMP, you must:

- Meet TSTC college admission requirements.
- Enroll in an associate degree program.
- Be a U.S. citizen/permanent resident.
- Be eligible for a Pell Grant.
- Have freshman status/be enrolled full time.

You or an immediate family member must have worked within the last 24 months for at least 75 days as a migrant or seasonal farmworker or you had participation in and eligibility for the Title 1C Migrant Education Program.

Services

CAMP is designed to serve first-year college students who come from migrant/seasonal farmworker backgrounds. Through intensive academic services, personal guidance and financial assistance, CAMP helps students transition from high school to college and develop the skills necessary to succeed at TSTC.

- Tutoring and academic skill-building instruction and assistance.
- Cultural enrichment.
- Career planning.
- Academic advising.
- Financial assistance.
- Support services.

¿Qué Es CAMP?

El Programa de Asistencia Universitaria para Migrantes (CAMP) en el Texas State Technical College (TSTC) en Harlingen es un programa financiado por el gobierno federal diseñado para satisfacer las necesidades de los estudiantes con antecedentes de trabajadores agrícolas migrantes y de temporada. CAMP ofrece a los estudiantes que sean elegibles, servicios de apoyo para la transición preuniversitaria y el primer año para ayudar a desarrollar las habilidades necesarias para tener éxito en la universidad. CAMP colabora con la facultad de TSTC, servicios estudiantiles, programas de extensión y agencias comunitarias para mejorar las oportunidades educativas y profesionales para todos los estudiantes elegibles para CAMP.

¿Quien Es Elegible?

Para calificar para el programa de CAMP debe:

- Cumplir los requisitos de admisión de TSTC.
- Inscribirse en un programa de títulos asociado.
- Ser un ciudadano estadounidense o residente legal.
- Ser elegible para Beca Pell.
- Estudiante de primer año/tiempo complete.

Usted o un familiar inmediato deben haber trabajado en los últimos 24 meses durante al menos 75 días como migrante o trabajador agrícola estacional o tuvo participación y elegibilidad para el Programa de Educación Migrante Título 1C.

Servicios

CAMP está diseñado para atender a estudiantes universitarios de primer año con trasfondos de trabajo migrante agrícolas/estacionales. A través de servicios académicos intensivos, orientación personal y asistencia financiera, CAMP ayuda a los estudiantes a realizar la transición de la escuela secundaria a la universidad y desarrollar las habilidades necesarias para tener éxito en TSTC.

- Tutoría e instrucción y asistencia para el desarrollo de habilidades académicas.
- Enriquecimiento cultural.
- Planificación de la carrera.
- Asesoramiento académico.
- Asistencia financiera.
