Goals of the Program:

- Provide a physically and emotionally safe place to promote healthy bodies, minds, and habits.

Expectations of Students:

- Care – Be mindful of other's feelings and their personal belongings.

- Honesty – Tell the truth even when it is difficult to do so.
- Integrity – Always do the right thing.
- Leadership – Make choices which benefit your learning as well as your peers.
- Responsibility – Be an active participant.
- Restraint – Be aware of your surroundings and help other stay safe.

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If a student is having difficulty following the above expectations, the following consequences are:

- Verbal warning
- Removal from the group
- Phone call to parent/guardian
- Suspension from Hornets of Character Program and/or bus

A behavior notification will be sent home to help keep parents and guardians updates. If a student receives three behavior notifications, the student will be suspended from Hornets of Character and/or the bus for a determined amount of time. Upon the student's return, (S)he will meet with the Director to discuss his/her choices and reflect on how choices benefit learning. It is our hope this procedure will help students meet their own needs as well as their classmates' needs.
