DINNER TIME LEARNING

TIPS for encouraging
language

Put learning on the dinner
table with these fun ideas:

- Hang a map in the dining area. Discuss the food you are eating.
- Share where the food comes from. (climate and conditions)
- Show-N-Tell at the table. Bring an object special to the table.
- Share about why it is special to your family.
- Table Talk... share about your day (positive and difficult).

SPOTLIGHT ON SUCCESS

Responding to student achievement

- When your student brings home test or graded assignment:
 - Ask what your student 'what' did he/she learn from the assignment or test information.
 - Ask if his/her effort was 110%

This will send a message that it is not just his/her grade that counts- It's also the effort he/she puts into their education and learning.

CREATING A MEANINGFUL CULTURAL PROJECT

- Encourage your child to think outside the box for displaying the information.
- Motivate your child to complete a finished product.
- Plan to make a special time for your child to present the project to the family. Give positive feedback.

GREAT IDEAS TO DEVELOP INTEREST AND RESPONSIBLE LEARNERS!

- Encourage your child to read NONFICTION books or magazines about things that are interesting to him/her.
- Go to your public library. Instead of checking out a book find several magazines on the rack to sit down and look at. LOOK at the covers and talk about what information a person could learn by looking at the pictures or reading the articles. A child that can read different informational text will help to prepare him/her for high school, college and a career path.
- Create a planning calendar showing school assignments that are due. Set goals on the amount of time needed to spend on studying for a test or working out problems.
- Create a list of assignments due and prioritize the assignment by due date and amount of time needed to complete the assignment
