The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE) and the Oklahoma College Assistance Program (OCAP) are offering an online tool to help counselors better assist their seniors in completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The **Oklahoma FAFSA Data Portal (OK-FDP)** lets counselors, principals and mentors provide targeted assistance to their students, which is instrumental in increasing FAFSA completion rates—especially for first-generation students pursuing postsecondary education.

After the district's Superintendent/School Board President/Chief Executive signs a Completion Agreement with OSRHE/OCAP, authorized users from Oklahoma high schools will have access to individual students' FAFSA completion status. Each cohort is securely matched to Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) data showing if the FAFSA is complete, not complete, chosen for verification or missing a student or parent signature.

### Receive Access to the OK-FDP

1. Sign and submit the Completion Agreement found at [UCanGo2.org/FAFSAPortal.html](http://UCanGo2.org/FAFSAPortal.html).
2. Identify authorized district users.
3. Provide a student list for the data match. This list may be revised and resubmitted as needed. Find directions and a student list template at [okhighered.org/ok-fdp](http://okhighered.org/ok-fdp).
4. Receive your secure access from OSRHE.
5. Check weekly for updates.
6. Follow policies and guidelines outlined in the agreement.

### The Importance of the FAFSA

- **90%** of high school seniors who complete the FAFSA will begin college.
- The Department of Education awards around **\$120 billion** in federal aid to nearly **13 million students** annually.
- **\$2.6 billion** in federal aid was unclaimed by 2018 grads who did not complete a FAFSA.
- Helping students—especially first-generation students from lower income families—complete the FAFSA significantly increases the odds that students will pursue higher education.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Who can receive “authorized user” access?

Authorized users are determined by the district’s Designated Signatory or Superintendent, who also determines the level of access.

Superintendents, principals, counselors, data technicians and administrators are the most common users.

## What details are included in the OK-FDP?

Users will be able to see the high school name along with each student’s first and last name, birthdate, FAFSA status, date of FAFSA submission and verification indicator as permitted by the Federal Student Aid office.

## Additional information

Each authorized user, consistent with Oklahoma governance provisions and all applicable security requirements, will have access to individual and aggregated data on student FAFSA completion. The portal features comply with privacy laws and protect Personally Identifiable Information (PII).
