- Seating will not be reserved. Seating in the bleachers will be marked in groups of 10 with a bleacher separating each family group.
  - Seating will also be available on the field. Please try and use these seats if you have a member of your family/group who is handicapped.

  - o Families are encouraged to bring their own chairs if they are planning on sitting on the field or not in the bleachers.

- Stadium gates will open at 7:30 PM.
- Graduates need to be at the high school cafeteria by 7:45 PM.

- Due to graduation taking place outside and the heat, I am asking students to dress comfortably and appropriately.
- Please limit the number of cars your family/family group brings to graduation.
- In order for our traditional graduation to be approved by the Department of Education there a number of guidelines our graduates, participants, and attendees have to adhere to. These guidelines are in place to make sure our parents, faculty, students, and community members remain safe and healthy while on campus.
  - O Social distancing will need to be followed while on campus. Please do not congregate in ANY areas.
    - After parking please go directly to entrances/exits.
    - Upon entering the stadium please go directly to your designated seating area.
    - After graduation please go directly to your car.
  - O Household groups may sit together but will be spaced 6ft apart from other groups.
    - Families can bring their own chairs.
  - Individuals 10 and above must wear a face mask/face covering upon entering the stadium, traveling, to seat, and
    exiting the stadium. Once an individual has arrived at their seat and is sitting among their family group it may be
    removed.
  - O Graduates may remove facemask for their picture after walking across stage.
    - ALL other pictures need to be taken off campus before or after graduation.
- Please remain home if you have a fever or are sick.
- Graduation will be live streamed so that people not able to attend will be able to watch it live.

- O Link will be sent out the week of graduation.
- We have submitted to the ADE a Plan B in case of rain and a Plan C in case of change of ADH guidelines due to recent COVID-19 spikes. I will be sending out details once those plans are approved.
