2. What is SHAC

The SHAC committee is made up of diverse representation from the school, law enforcement, EMS, community service organizations, parents, and faith-based community groups. SHAC is a wholistic approach to children's health and education colaberating with the Family, community, and school. The SHAC committee will discuss, research, and recommend to the BISD school board policies and practices in regard to this is goal.

SHATTERED DREAMS [being set up for February] accident simulation due to drunk driving

AIM? Abstinence promotion

3. Goals for this year

a. What areas do the students need more education? Discussion followed:

Drug and Alcohol prevention

Synthetic marijuana usage needs to be address

Could we set up a heath care fair?

Possible goal: setting up intervention resources. District wide training for teachers couches as to what to do when a student is using drugs.

Online safety training is a definite needed: sexing, cyber bullying, ect

Could suicide concern reporting be added to the CRISIS Go app?

b. Concerns

- WE need to address what to do when family, friends, and our yourself is caught in adiction, not just say don't do it
- We can't get parents to come to meetings, could we have some type of presence for drug prevention/intervention at sporting events? Concerns raised about large age range, UIL time limits
- What way can we help kids that are already addicted?
- Suicide training, the district already has mandatory training, but we need more, possibly training for students
