

2014-2015 Highly Qualified Teacher Report- Public Reporting Requirement

In regard to School Year 2014-15, Ranch Academy continues to utilize highly qualified teachers in all classrooms on both campuses with one exception. On the Tyler Campus, Ranch Academy has hired one teacher, Kathey Denham, who is not currently Highly Qualified to teach Science classes for grades 8-12. She is certified in other content areas, has relevant teaching experience and college coursework in Science, and is scheduled to take her State Certification exam in Science 7-12 in January 2015. A completed and signed HQTCIP and Principal Attestation Statement are on file attesting to that fact on both the Tyler Campus and the Ranch Academy District Office.
