



## Back to School Health & Safety Information

### PREVENTION

- Students will be screened daily by parents before coming to school. Students showing symptoms will be screened and temperature will be checked by school staff. (Screening documents can be found on the district's website under the "BACK TO SCHOOL 2020" link.
- Teachers and staff will self-screen daily for COVID-19 symptoms. JISD is working on an APP for this purpose.
- Visitors will be screened for COVID-19 upon arrival and will not be allowed in the building except in the front offices, unless necessary.
- Students displaying symptoms of COVID-19 will be separated from other students until a parent or guardian can come pick them up.
- All areas will be cleaned and sanitized as soon as feasible following the notification of a sick student or staff member.
- Buildings will be sprayed, cleaned, and wiped down in a very strategic manner. Buses will be cleaned after morning and evening routes. We encourage anyone who has transportation to drop-off and pick-up their child to minimize the numbers on the buses.

### MITIGATION

- Frequent handwashing and sanitizing will be taught and ensured by staff throughout the day.
- Desks, keyboards, doorknobs, and bathrooms and other high-traffic areas will be cleaned frequently throughout the day.
- The Governor's order requiring the use of face coverings is expected to be followed for staff and students unless it is deemed impractical for a valid reason on a case by case basis. Social distancing will be encouraged at all times, particularly in high traffic areas such as hallways, school buses, and locker rooms, though it cannot be guaranteed at all times.
- Students will not congregate in assemblies or other large groups.

### RESPONSE

- Jefferson ISD will stay in contact with local health officials to determine the severity of spread in our area. Any pertinent information we receive will be shared with parents as soon as time permits.
- Any student, employee, or campus visitor who tests positive for COVID-19, or exhibits the symptoms of COVID-19, must stay at home throughout the infection period, and cannot return until the re-entry criteria are met.
