Dumas High School Seniors
\$20,000 Scholarship

Due: May 1, 2019

Criteria: First year students who are attending college at a four year university. Applicants may receive additional scholarships as long as those scholarships are not based on athletic ability and they do not total more than 50% of the total 4 year value of this scholarship. Must show proof of applying for FAFSA. The scholarship will be paid out over the course of four years. Applicants must submit paperwork provided each semester to ensure the grade average of 2.5 is met along with the minimum course load.

Scholarships will be reviewed and judged by non-Moore County residents.

All the information listed below is required for the scholarship committee to review your application.

1. A current official transcript of your high school record. This transcript should indicate your grade average through the last semester completed prior to applying for this scholarship.
2. A copy of your official SAT or ACT test scores.
3. Page one of your parents 2015 Federal Income Tax Return. You MUST black out the social security numbers. Once the income is ranked according to a chart, this page will be shredded and will not follow the scholarship application for the judges.
4. Attach the email you receive stating the proof of submitted FAFSA application.
5. Attach an essay of no more than 300 words, answering the following question: What is the biggest challenge you faced while attending high school and how did you overcome it? (The challenge does not have to be academic specific.)
6. Attach one letter of recommendation.
